From Mr. McLaverty

- ✓ As we prepare to enter our third week of school next Monday, students are advised that they should have all parts of their uniform in place. Reminder that **shoes** must be **all black, with no markings** and that outside hoodies, sweaters, jackets etc. are not to be worn in class. Also, please note that school hoodies, sweaters or vests are a second layer of uniform clothing and you must have your uniform polo or white shirt underneath. Gym shirts, other shirts, or no shirts underneath are not acceptable. Also, very important that uniform **socks can only be grey, black or blue** and girls must wear knee socks or tights; "no shows" and white are not permitted.
- ✓ **Grade 10 and 12 students** are advised that the **provincial literacy assessments** are due to be written this fall.

Grade 12s are scheduled for October 31st and November 1st.

Grade 10s are set for November 3rd and 4th.

Mr. McLaverty will make arrangements to meet with students within the next week and a half to discuss preparations.

Grade 11 students who wrote their Numeracy last April can now obtain their results from Mr. McLaverty.

✓ **Students** still requiring **parking passes** must drop off their car details, including make, model, colour and license plate at the office. **Parking for students is only permitted in the Sacred Heart parking lot**, not in any lot around the school including the gravel area by the gym.
