- ✓ Are you in proper uniform? Reminder that **shoes** must be **all black, with no markings** and that outside hoodies, sweaters, jackets etc. are **not to be worn in class**. Also, please note that school hoodies, sweaters or vests are a second layer of uniform clothing and you must have your uniform polo or white shirt underneath. Gym shirts, other shirts, or no shirts underneath are not acceptable. Also, very important that uniform **socks can only be grey, black or blue** and girls must wear knee socks or tights; “no shows” and white are not permitted.
