From Mr. Niwa

Tomorrow we have the opportunity to pause and ponder the sacrifices that countless men and women from the navy, air force, and army have made during times of war and conflict. We must also remember our members of the Canadian peacekeeping forces who have also lost their lives. Our Canadian Armed Forces have served, and continue to serve, by helping societies in innumerable ways not only in times of war, but also in times of crisis, such as natural disasters.

Remembrance Day is not just about honoring the past; it's about acknowledging and taking the time to intentionally show our appreciation for the courage and sacrifice that shapes our present and future. It's about the soldiers who left their homes and families, not for glory and recognition, but for a cause greater than themselves. They fought and continue to fight for our freedom, our values, and our way of life. As Canadians, we are fortunate to live in one of the best countries in the world. We are especially fortunate to live in Victoria which was recently ranked the best small city in the world.

We must remember that conflict impacts all. We often focus our attention on the fallen soldiers; however, conflict impacts those who have returned as well. Whether it is the trauma to their bodies or to their minds, they are forever changed by their experiences. We must also remember families who have lost their loved ones and the deep loss this causes. They have been impacted as well. In the preceding weeks to Remembrance Day, we wear the red poppy, a symbol to help us remember as well as commitment a pledging that we will always remember, in gratitude, those who given the greatest sacrifice so we can have the gift of peace.

I challenge you to keep this pledge by taking a few moments of your time on Remembrance Day to offer a prayer of gratitude for those who will never return home and for those who have. In your prayer, remember that their sacrifice is for the benefit of all.
