#### Dear Families,

We have received a number of phone calls with expressions of some concern for drivers using Sevenoaks Road and Nelthorpe Street in the neighbourhood across the road from the school, behind McKenzie, as they prepare to pick up students after school.

Residents there are expressing some frustration as apparently some drivers are parking in residential spots or blocking driveways and even speeding along the narrow street while en route to St. Andrew's. Some cars, in an attempt to beat the light at Nelthorpe and McKenzie, are also getting stuck in the

intersection, blocking traffic.

Therefore, we ask in consideration of the safety of our students, and maintaining good relations with our neighbours that drivers take measures to keep those areas as clear as possible. Effective steps can include delaying or staggering your pickup time and even better, drivers can use the larger parking lot behind the school by Sacred Heart for safer pickup. That parking lot can be accessed from Saanich Road as well.



One further note is that all yellow curbs in the school driveway are absolutely no stopping zones. Thank you for your support and cooperation.


## Religion Department


