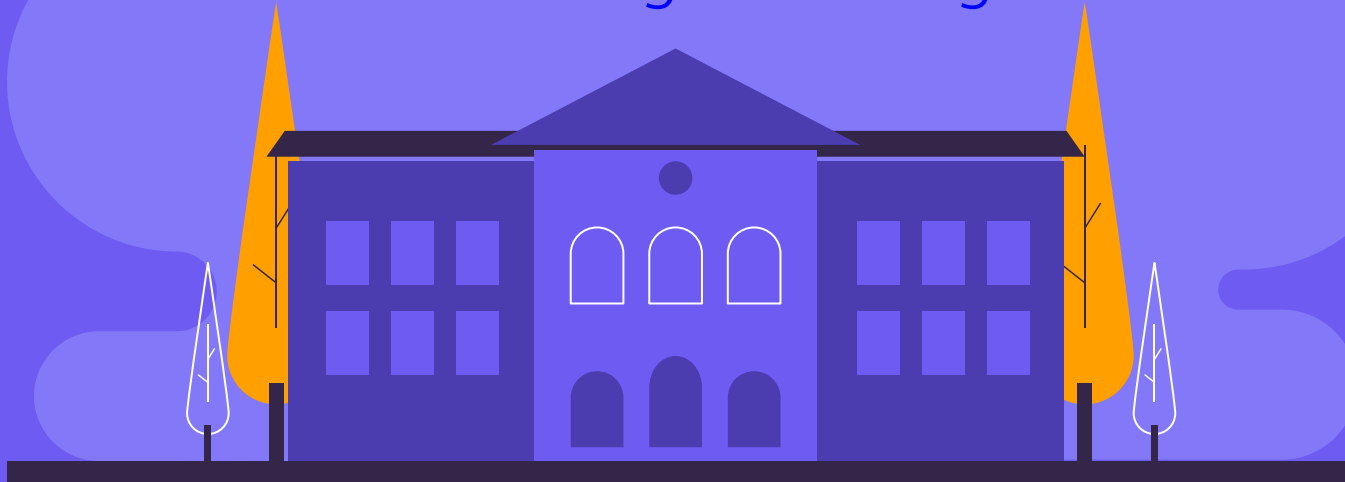

Decision-Making in Grade 9

- **Second Language:** French or Spanish depending on preference - only students with IEPs have the option to not take a second language and have a Support Block instead
- **Elective:** Students will take one Fine Arts 9 elective and one Applied Design, Skills, and Technologies (ADST) 9 elective (there are three options for each type of elective)



Fine Arts Electives

- **Visual Arts 9 (max 50 students randomly chosen by MyEd)**
- **Drama 9 (max 52)**
- **Guitar 9 (max 50)**



ADST Electives

- **Food Studies 9 (max 36 students)**
- **Digital Photography 9 (max 40)**
- **IT (Computers) 9 (max 52)**



Note on Rowing Academy 9-12

- Gathering interest during course selection
- Will likely fall during Grade 9 elective block (please still choose electives on paper course selection form as backup)
- Cost to be determined (approx. \$600+)

- **Alternative Selection:** Students are asked to provide an alternate choice in their grade 9 course selection. Students should see an academic advisor / counsellor if they have questions about other courses they may wish to pursue during grade 9.
