This past Sunday at mass we heard the beatitudes. The 8 beatitudes are the teachings that God wants us to live by. These teachings show us what true humility looks like, holding up the poor, mourning, meek, those seeking righteousness, the merciful, the pure in heart, the peacemakers, and the persecuted. Jesus' message is the opposite of the one the world gives - not the rich and powerful but the humble and selfless are called 'blessed', a word that also means 'happy' or 'fortunate'. The beatitudes offer guidance on where to look for holiness and virtue, call us to see others as Christ sees them, and show us how He wants us to live.
